UHC has issued amendment's regarding updating your fee schedule to be implemented August 1st. If you do not accept the modifications, you are required to notify UHC in writing within 30 days (by May 23rd).

I personally have read the terms of the contract carefully and have sent UHC in writing that I do not accept the modifications to my fee schedule. NTENT cannot make this decision on your behalf, but if you do not accept the modifications for you, please send in writing to UHC that you do not accept. Otherwise, your fee schedule will change August 1, 2020.

Beginning on April 26, 2020 CMS stopped accepting any new applications for the Advance Payment Program, and CMS will be reevaluating all pending and new applications for Accelerated Payments in light of historical direct payments made available through HHS's Provider Relief Fund. COVID-19 UPDATE For Patient Examinations and Procedures

The Texas Medical Board (TMB) has issued guidance for Compliance Requirements concerning COVID-19 for procedures and surgeries. We have summarized for quick reading or click here for the entire document.

- 1. A mask must be worn when within 6 feet from patient. (both patient and physician) You can require a mask be worn but if a patient does not have their own, an office must provide some type of face covering.
- 2. Follow policy on screening and testing for patients
- 3. Prior to patient visit, screen for symptoms of COVID-19 and verify if patient has not been screened in the last 20 days.
- Any procedure or surgery performed that has a high risk or aerosol transmission should include N95 masks or equivalent protection from aerosolized particles and face shields.

It is recommended but not required that you document compliance (especially minimum safety equipment standards for high risk of aerosol transmission) and if you informed the

patient of safe practice measures.
